

Local Law 1 of 2000 - Animal Control: Noise and
Property Damage

No owner or person having custody of any dog within the legal limits of the Town of Lake Pleasant shall allow such dog to unnecessarily annoy or disturb any person by continued or repeated barking, howling or yelping, or any other loud or unusual noises.

Upon written complaint by the person or persons disturbed, signed and sworn to, any duly qualified law enforcement official may investigate and may give written notice to the owner or keeper of such dog, that such annoyance or disturbance must cease. The warning shall be made a part of the complaint.

Thereafter, upon continuance of such annoyance or disturbance, such owner shall be charged with a civil violation, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of up to \$25 for the first offense. Each additional conviction after the first conviction shall be punishable by a fine of up to \$50. All fines so assessed shall be recovered for use of the Town of Lake Pleasant through Lake Pleasant Town Court.
