

A Local Law Prohibiting the Parking of Vehicles on all Highways, Roads, Public Streets, Shoulders and Rights-of-Way in the Town of Lake Pleasant.

Section I. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited on all highways, roads, public streets, shoulders, and rights-of-way within the Town of Lake Pleasant during road maintenance (snow removal, ice removal, sanding and resurfacing) or anyplace that hinders the flow of traffic.

Section II. A violation of this Local Law is an offense punishable by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). In addition thereto, the Town of Lake Pleasant shall have such other remedies as are provided by law to restrain, correct or abate any violation of this Local Law.

Section III. The town Superintendent of Highways is hereby authorized to cause any vehicle found parked left standing on any highway, road, public street, shoulder or right-of-way in the Town of Lake Pleasant during the dates and hours (10pm through 8am beginning December 1st and ending March 31st) prohibited by this Local Law to be towed away and removed from such highway, road, public street, shoulder or right-of-way and in lieu of fine, the owner of such vehicle or the person who parked such vehicle or left the same standing in violation of this Local Law may pay the actual and reasonable cost of towing or removing such vehicle from the highway, road, public street, shoulder or right-of-way, not exceeding the sum of \$100.00.

Section IV. The location of basketball hoops or structures or other obstructions is hereby prohibited on all highway, road, public street, shoulder and rights-of-way within the Town of Lake Pleasant. Consistent with Highway Law Sections 319 and 157 the town Superintendent of Highways is hereby authorized to cause any basketball hoop or structure or similar obstruction found on any highway, road, public street, shoulder or right-of-way in the Town of Lake Pleasant to be removed. In addition to the fine specified in Section II, the Superintendent of Highways is also authorized to charge the owner of such basketball hoop or structure or obstruction for the actual and reasonable cost and expenses of removing and storing such basketball hoop or structure or obstruction.

Section V. This Local Law shall become effective immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
